Scholarship Information January 2011

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicant must be a member of the current graduation class of North, South, Kohler, Christian, or Lutheran high schools.
2. Applicant must have a cumulative minimum "B" (3.0) grade point average for all years of high school attendance.
3. Applicant must demonstrate a capacity for leadership and good character qualities.
4. Applicant must show active involvement and leadership in community, school, work, and/or church activities.
5. Applicant achievements must be representative of those that would be attributed to a "good" and "involved" student.

Note:

1. Academic excellence and financial necessity shall not be required for qualification, nor shall they be a basis for qualification.
2. Acceptance of any other scholarship shall not preclude acceptance, however a candidate's receipt of other significant scholarship funding may be taken into account as a factor in final selection.
3. The proceeds of the award shall be used to assist the recipient in meeting tuition, room, board, fees, and other institutional charges associated with advanced education in a full course of study leading to a degree at a college, university, technical/trade school or their equivalent.
4. One eight thousand dollar (\$8000) scholarship will be awarded to the finalist. The first installment will be paid upon satisfactory indication that enrollment in advanced education has been undertaken, and the second installment to be paid at the commencement of the second semester or immediately prior thereto upon satisfactory demonstration that school enrollments and attendance has been continued and that the first semester performance was at a passing level.
5. Applications must be submitted on the "Sheboygan Downtown Rotary Scholarship Application" form distributed via the high school guidance offices or printed from the Sheboygan Rotary Club website at www.sheboyganrotary.org. **Completed forms must be available for pick up from the high school guidance offices by the deadline of March 1, 2011.**
